## OUR COMMITMENTS TO YOU

Lynne \& Neil value the strong sense of community in Old Windsor, the Great Park and 'The Boltons' - and if re-elected will continue to represent all residents to the best of their ability.

We PROMISE to do all that we can to deliver on the following commitments:

- RESTORE RBWM finances and quality of service - e.g. outsourcing is not always the answer but where outsourced services bring economies of scale then effective contract management must be in place
- REVIEW all Children's \& Adults services to prioritise the 'early help' and preventative services and to reverse cuts wherever feasible
- REVERSE the decline in Social Rented homes
- REINSTATE investment in replanting and maintaining the borough's street trees and truly protect our greenbelt
- RECONSIDER resident parking schemes so residents are not penalised by 'tourist parking charges' and put off shopping in town centres
- TRULY consult with and listen to residents - not just treat consultation as a 'tick box' exercise, then ignore the results
- SUPPORT the creation of a Windsor Town Council
- MAKE decisions based on evidence and RBWM officers' professional expertise and knowledge
- CONTINUE to lobby for Channel 1 of the 'River Thames Scheme' as the only viable solution to local flooding

We don't pretend any of this is easy - we are seeking to reverse 16 years of decline - but if all Councillors work together, with honesty, transparency, respect, and willingness to do what is best for residents, we will be able to dig ourselves out of this mess.
